
You can turn on Restrictions, also known as parental controls, on the iPad


You can use Restrictions to prevent access to specific apps and features.

This presentation will help you learn about the types of Restrictions and how to turn them on and off on your device.


First begin by touching the settings icon. You will be directed to this page.









After you have been taken to the Settings page you will need to select General.






Select Enable Restrictions




You will be asked to create a passcode. You must enter a passcode to make restrictions. The student will not be able to alter the restrictions unless they have the passcode. You will be asked to re-enter your passcode.




From this screen you will be able to control all restrictions. We go line by line. If you want to restrict anything under allow you will turn off the green button by touching it.




The buttons for the items to be restricted will be gray, You can turn on or off any category.




sections with the green buttons you will find allowed content. You will be able to restrict content on these sections.










Select Movies












If you turn off the button. The books section on the restricted page will say Restricted.
