Migrant Summer School

June 13th-July 15th

Welcome to Migrant Summer School 2016! We are very excited to provide an all-inclusive 5 week summer program for Migrant students K-12, within a 50 mile radius of Alexandria, IN. The program lasts 5 weeks during the months of June and July, with a focus on academic skills and technological discovery. The program exists to ensure migrant students are fully prepared for their next school year, helping avoid that "summer slump".



The Indiana Migrant Education Program has teamed up with technology-in-education leaders from across the state to create a student-centered STEM (Science Technology Engineering Mathematics) curriculum for all migrant summer programs. We are thrilled to have this curriculum as our centerpiece for learning. Summer school will run June 13th through July 15th, from 8:30am to 4pm (Monday-Friday). Student's typical day can be found here, but the emphasis will be on STEM, Language Arts, and Mathematics in the morning with STEM, Physical Education, and Art in the afternoon.

Migrant Summer School staff will be hired from across the region to ensure students from all areas have a smooth transition to the Regular School Year. Summer school will be located at Alexandria Community Schools in Alexandria, IN, and all students eligible to attend will have the option of being transported to and from school by Migrant Summer School buses.
